#### **Programm**

#### **Five Miniatures (2003)**

Five music miniatures composed with the sounds of various metal objects and percussion instruments, each representing a specific psychological mood.

#### **Study for Tzouras (2005)**

Tzouras is a Greek traditional instrument, which history, goes back to ancient Greek times, keeping also a connection with the Arabic/Turkish tradition as well. With this piece I try to express my worries about the discontinuation between the "Traditional" and the "Contemporary" in our modern, full consumptional and fast-changing-societies.

#### m pets (2008)

"m" pets, from "My" pets or from "Monster" pets. Some of their voices I do believe that exist in that piece.

#### The companions of me (2004)

Sudden musical events try to map the inner horizon.

These events are organized in time in a symmetrical way (via Fibonacci series), and are supported by a "continuous", a non-stop sound during the whole piece, that brings in mind the "Iso" of the ritual Byzantine Music.

(trombone: Marton Regöczi)

Trombone's sound viewed like a continuous line in the aspect of time, bringing perhaps

in mind one's own path in life: evaluating but also staying the same.

The piece was written for an Algorithmic Composition Projekt with a combination of

Markov Models and Generative Grammars.
