graindrop~ is a granular synthesis object for Pure data. It focuses on combining the most creative methods of granular synthesis in one interface and a single software sound generator. For the vast amount of control data required, sources such as physical modelling algorithms or various recorded data —like motion tracking— are recruited, not just to achieve a specific kind of sound (natural, ecological sound) but to show the possibilities of one of the most inspiring synthesis techniques and bring the modern 'mighty' computer down on its knees.

Being a long-term work-in-progress, graindrop~'s main function is to provide an environment for my needs in experimenting with computer sound generation. Furthermore, it stores and reflects my progress in research and programming in this field.

In this Open CUBE event graindrop~'s main features will be presented alongside with compositions made with it.
